General Rules

1. The Competition is open to everyone.
2. Participants must provide their own ingredients and own equipment for making the potjie.
3. Potjies can start cooking from 10h00 onwards. Potjies need to be plated for judging no later than 15h00.
4. Coals/fires can be made prior to 10h00.
5. The potjie must include a side dish as well as bread or sweet.
6. The Judges decision will be final.
7. Each entrant must clean their own area, leaving it in the same condition as found before leaving at the end of the day.
8. Great Prizes to be won.

Cook-site Competition Judging Criteria -

1. Judges will visit the cooking sites after setup and during the afternoon whilst potjies are being prepared.
2. The Judges will be scoring :
1-2 Poor 3-4 Satisfactory 5-6 Good 7-8 Very Good 9-10 Excellent
 On the following criteria
 The cooking area / the general spirit of the team or individual / originality / preparation techniques / best themed / and general impression.
3. Your potjie dish will receive a score on the following criteria :
 Aroma, Colour, Taste, Texture, Ingredients.

Potjie Competition Rules

1. All the potjies must be prepared from scratch on the day of the competition. Prior marinating of fish/meat will be allowed.
2. All entries must be cooked in a traditional cast iron African pot or potjie.
3. Potjies can be cooked over wood, coals or gas burners.
4. Cut off time for providing food for judging is 15h00.
